



How to apply for the fund

Applying for the fund is easy!

1. Fill in an application form.
Download from the Council website or pick one up from Council.
2. Get two quotes from registered tradespersons.
3. Take a few photos of the proposed areas of work and setting of the building.
4. Owner's consent will be required if the applicant is not the owner.

Please note: Some projects may require a development application to be lodged for the proposed works to be undertaken. Council will advise you if this is necessary for your nominated project.

What is the Mosman Heritage Assistance Fund?

The Mosman Heritage Assistance Fund was established by Mosman Council in 1998.

The fund provides \$ for \$ funding for conservation work to heritage items and properties located within heritage conservation areas as defined by the Mosman Local Environmental Plan.



Projects funded in the past

Examples of projects which have been funded in the past include:

-  Fencing repair and replacement
-  Repair and replacement to roof elements
-  Painting of facade in heritage colours
-  Leadlight window repairs and reinstatement
-  Preparation of Conservation Management Plans for state significant heritage items

How much funding is provided?

Funding is provided as follows:

-  Up to \$3000 for work to properties which are heritage items
-  Up to \$1000 for work to properties which are located within heritage conservation areas









Project eligibility for funding

To be eligible for funding, work must be undertaken on a heritage listed property or property within a heritage conservation area.

Projects may involve repair, maintenance or reinstatement works, and should be visible from the public domain.

Projects ineligible for funding

Funding will not be provided for the following projects:

-  Works that have already been completed
-  New additions to a heritage building
-  Work on a government owned building still used for a government purpose
-  Where assistance is reasonably available from another source
-  The purchase of a building, site or moveable item
-  Where substantial assistance has been previously provided or where the applicant has yet to complete other assisted projects
-  Relocation of a heritage building or work on a relocated building
